What is SSPA?

It's a group of social service agencies formed to combat rising costs and save money on goods and services all non-profits need.

How Does SSPA Do It?

SSPA negotiates directly with providers of goods and services using the power of bulk purchasing to receive discounted rates only available to SSPA members. The most popular insurance programs are health (Oxford) and dental (Delta Dental). You will also have access to vision and life insurance and deeply discounted food and supplies.

Once you become a member you deal directly with the provider of the service to receive the SSPA pre-negotiated special rates. In most cases, purchasing through SSPA is less expensive and offers improved or expanded benefits over your current programs.

Is My Non-profit Eligible to Participate in the SSPA?

If you answer "yes" to any one of these questions and you are a non-profit corporation, you can become a member and take advantage of these money-saving programs:

1. Do you contract with the State of NJ to provide social services?
2. Are you an association of social service agencies who contracts with the State of NJ?
3. Are you a subcontractor to one of the two entities above?

How Does An Organization Become a Member?

1. It's easy! Check the eligibility criteria above.
2. Go to sspanj.org.
3. Fill out the agreement, calculate your dues, and mail to the address below. Dues are \$100, \$250 or \$500 annually, depending on your agency's operating budget.
